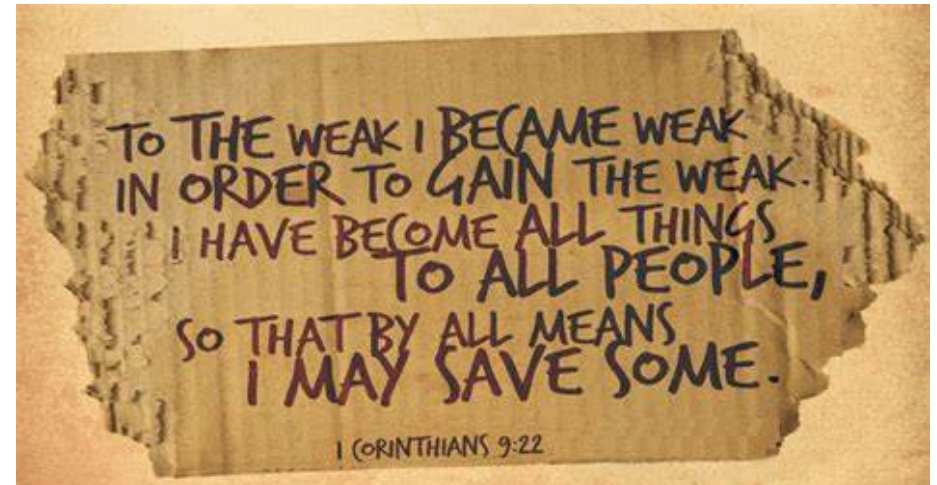
Monday, 3/27, 7:00pm - Ladies Christian Fellowship meets in the Junior Church classroom (last room on the right down the hallway).
